This list is a guideline for your use in preparing for a hurricane event. It is not meant to be all inclusive. There are many websites with lists to access for additional resources. This list covers the most common items found on many lists for your reference and use.

<b>FOOD AND KITCHEN SUPPLIES:</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Drinking Water: 1 gallon/person per day for 3-7 days
<input type="checkbox"/>	Non-perishable food for a 3-7 day supply. (Best if used without cooking)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Manual can opener
<input type="checkbox"/>	Juice/soft drinks/instant coffee or tea
<input type="checkbox"/>	Plastic wrap/zip-lock bags/garbage bags
<input type="checkbox"/>	Paper plates, cups, utensils, aluminum foil
<input type="checkbox"/>	Cooler(s) for food storage and ice
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lighter/matches (keep matches in water proof container)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Camp stove or grill—outdoor use only
<input type="checkbox"/>	Charcoal and/or propane tanks
<input type="checkbox"/>	Infant formulas, bottles, diapers, wipes and diaper rash cream

### PERSONAL ITEMS:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Sleeping bags, pillows, blankets
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lawn chairs, folding chairs, cots
<input type="checkbox"/>	Personal hygiene items
<input type="checkbox"/>	Prescriptions and over-the-counter meds (2 week supply at least)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spare glasses, sunglasses, contacts and contact cases, cleaning solution
<input type="checkbox"/>	Extra hearing aid batteries (if applicable)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rain gear, jackets, hats, umbrellas and boots, hot and cold weather clothing
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sturdy shoes or boots, Closed-toe work shoes (not just sandals), work gloves
<input type="checkbox"/>	If evacuating, take several changes of clothes per person
<input type="checkbox"/>	Extra cash (ATMs may not work)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Masks for everyone ages 2 and above
<input type="checkbox"/>	Laptops, iPads/Tablets, cell phones, AirPods/Earphones and charging cords (also car charging cords)

### BASIC TOOLS:

### SANITATION / CLEANUP SUPPLIES:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Water for cleaning—could be water drawn in a bathtub or purchase a water balloon for the tub
<input type="checkbox"/>	Unscented bleach
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rubber gloves
<input type="checkbox"/>	Wet wipes and waterless hand sanitizers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Toilet paper, paper towels, sanitary supplies
<input type="checkbox"/>	Assorted cleaners and disinfectants
<input type="checkbox"/>	Brooms, mops, towels, and rags
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bucket with tight fitting lid for emergency toilet or portable toilet

### BASIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

<input type="checkbox"/>	NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert (with crank or extra batteries) (easily purchased for \$20-\$40)
<input type="checkbox"/>	First-aid kit and instruction book
<input type="checkbox"/>	A landline telephone can help (does not require batteries or electricity)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Battery powered television, radio, clock (cell phone apps can work for this)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Flashlights
<input type="checkbox"/>	Extra batteries (multiple sizes e.g., AA, AAA, C, D, etc)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chemical light sticks (to replace candles)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Whistle (to signal for help if needed)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Cell phone(s) - charge them in advance
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spare keys (home, vehicles, boats, etc.)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Prepaid telephone cards if you don't have cell phone(s)



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<input type="checkbox"/>	Pens, pencils, and paper
<input type="checkbox"/>	Maps (paper) and evacuation information
<input type="checkbox"/>	Keepsakes, significant photos, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Books, Kindle(s), games and other quiet entertainment
<input type="checkbox"/>	Medical equipment (serial number, manufacturer and supplying Company)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Cooler with ability to quickly add ice packs for medicines, food, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Medical alert tags
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fire Extinguisher
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bleach (without lemon or any additives)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fuel can and fuel, canned heat
<input type="checkbox"/>	Portable, battery powered lanterns
<input type="checkbox"/>	Mosquito repellent
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hard Hat

### PET CARE/SERVICE ANIMAL ITEMS
