

This list is a guideline for your use in preparing for a hurricane event. It is not meant to be all inclusive. There are many websites with lists to access for additional resources. This list covers the most common items found on many lists for your reference and use.

Blank spaces have been provided for you to add your customized items.

| FOC | DD AND KITCHEN SUPPLIES: |
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| | Drinking Water: 1 gallon/person per day for 3-7 days |
| | Non-perishable food for a 3-7 day supply. (Best if used without cooking) |
| | Manual can opener |
| | Juice/soft drinks/instant coffee or tea |
| | Plastic wrap/zip-lock bags/garbage bags |
| | Paper plates, cups, utensils, aluminum foil |
| | Cooler(s) for food storage and ice |
| | Lighter/matches (keep matches in water proof container) |
| | Camp stove or grill—outdoor use only |
| | Charcoal and/or propane tanks |
| | Infant formulas, bottles, diapers, wipes and diaper rash cream |
| | Pet food |
| | Paper towels |
| | Canned meats, fruits, vegetables, soups, puddings |
| | Crackers, cereals, snacks, dried fruit, peanut butter & jelly |
| | Sugar/sweetener, powdered creamer |
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Cape Royal HURRICANE SUPPLY CHECKLIST

| PERSONAL ITEMS: | |
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| | Sleeping bags, pillows, blankets |
| | Lawn chairs, folding chairs, cots |
| | Personal hygiene items |
| | Prescriptions and over-the-counter meds (2 week supply at least) |
| | Spare glasses, sunglasses, contacts and contact cases, cleaning solution |
| | Extra hearing aid batteries (if applicable) |
| | Rain gear, jackets, hats, umbrellas and boots, hot and cold weather clothing |
| | Sturdy shoes or boots, Closed-toe work shoes (not just sandals), work gloves |
| | If evacuating, take several changes of clothes per person |
| | Extra cash (ATMs may not work) |
| | Masks for everyone ages 2 and above |
| | Laptops, iPads/Tablets, cell phones, AirPods/Earphones and charging cords (also car charging cords) |
| | Sunscreen |
| | Thermometer |
| | Hand Sanitizer |
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BASIC TOOLS:

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| | Hammer, wrenches, screwdrivers, pliers, large scissors |
| | Specialized tools for water and gas valves, etc. |
| | Plastic tarps with grommets or roll plastic sheeting |
| | Assorted screws, nails or other fasteners |
| | Duct tape |
| | Canvas and/or leather work gloves |
| | Hand-crank for electric hurricane shutters |
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SANITATION / CLEANUP SUPPLIES:

| Water for cleaning—could be water drawn in a bathtub or purchase a water balloon for the tub |
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| Unscented bleach |
| Rubber gloves |
| Wet wipes and waterless hand sanitizers |
| Toilet paper, paper towels, sanitary supplies |
| Assorted cleaners and disinfectants |
| Brooms, mops, towels, and rags |
| Bucket with tight fitting lid for emergency toilet or portable toilet |
| Soap |
| Plunger |
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BASIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

| NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert (with crank or extra batteries) (easily purchased for \$20-\$40) |
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| First-aid kit and instruction book |
| A landline telephone can help (does not require batteries or electricity) |
| Battery powered television, radio, clock (cell phone apps can work for this) |
| Flashlights |
| Extra batteries (multiple sizes e.g., AA, AAA, C, D, etc) |
| Chemical light sticks (to replace candles) |
| Whistle (to signal for help if needed) |
| Cell phone(s) - charge them in advance |
| Spare keys (home, vehicles, boats, etc.) |
| Prepaid telephone cards if you don't have cell phone(s) |

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| Maps (paper) and evacuation information |
| Keepsakes, significant photos, etc. |
| Books, Kindle(s), games and other quiet entertainment |
| Medical equipment (serial number, manufacturer and supplying Company |
| Cooler with ability to quickly add ice packs for medicines, food, etc. |
| Medical alert tags |
| Fire Extinguisher |
| Bleach (without lemon or any additives) |
| Fuel can and fuel, canned heat |
| Portable, battery powered lanterns |
| Mosquito repellent |
| Hard Hat |

| Proper Identification |
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| Pet food and water for at least 7 days |
| Medical records/microchip information |
| A carrier or cage |
| Muzzle and Leash |
| Water and food bowls |
| Medications |
| Supplies for your service animal |
| Any special items for your pet to feel safe |
| Veterinarian name, location and phone number |
